

USLRA Amateur Ranking Rules

Rules:

- Amateur log-rollers will be ranked according to their best 3 finishes in qualified tournaments in the previous year
- A qualified tournament must meet the following criteria:
 - Registration must be open to all competitors, and open at least 30 days prior to the tournament
 - USLRA notified at least 30 days prior to the tournament with all necessary details (date, time, location, registration link, etc.)
 - USLRA Logrolling rules apply
- There must be at least 4 competitors in a division for rollers of that division to receive ranking points. Each division must have independent results.
- You must be a paid member of USLRA on day of tournament to receive ranking points
- Competitors who move up a division will carry half of the points earned in their previous division
- Tiebreakers will only be applied to rollers that have been at least 2 tournaments
- Rollers who have only been in one tournament and have the same number of points will have the same rank

The points for ranking will be:

First Place	8
Second Place	7
Third Place	6
Fourth Place	5
Fifth Place	4
Sixth Place	3
Seventh Place	2
Eight Place	1

Tiebreak Procedure:

1. If the competitors have had any head-to-head matches during the season, whoever has won more times will earn the higher ranking
2. The competitor who has placed the highest at the designated World Championships
3. The competitor who has achieved the highest average placement in all tournaments attended that had 4 or more competitors
4. The competitor who has achieved the highest place in a tournament with 4 or more competitors
5. The competitor who has attended the most tournaments
6. Coin toss
